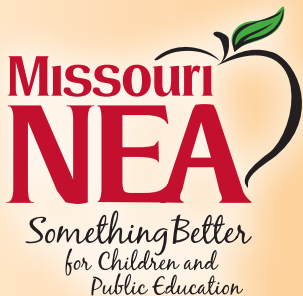

# MNEA Membership

Missouri NEA membership is your ticket to a wide array of benefits that help you provide the best possible education for Missouri's students and give you the financial advantage that comes with the buying power of the 3-million-member NEA. Following are the highlights of the benefits every member enjoys.

**As an education support professional, you are a key player on the education team that prepares Missouri's children for the future.**

Without you, kids wouldn't get extra help and attention, the bell wouldn't ring, the buses wouldn't run, the budgets wouldn't be finalized, the phones wouldn't be answered, nutritious meals wouldn't be served, and classrooms wouldn't be safe and clean. Without you, education wouldn't happen.

But these days it's getting harder and harder to do your job. School budgets are stretched to the breaking point, and you're expected to do more with less. Your association knows what you're up against and keeps you connected to your profession, to your peers and to your community.

- Bargain better contracts. Win better pay, benefits and working conditions.

## ADVOCACY AND REPRESENTATION

- Immediate, personal assistance from trained local leaders and professional staff (Call your UniServ director at the first hint of trouble. Many situations can be resolved informally in the early stages.)
- Collective bargaining assistance for your salary, benefits, working conditions and job security (No other organization matches MNEA's expertise and experience on this issue.)
- \$4 million professional liability insurance in your employment
- Workshops on school safety, school-employee rights and responsibilities, collective bargaining and school finance
- Legal representation to all members accused of abuse or neglect (False allegations of abuse comprise a large percentage of the cases MNEA funds each year.)
- Members also get two free half-hour consultations with an attorney each year for personal matters, such as traffic violations, consumer protection, domestic relations, real estate issues and wills and estates. Additional time needed beyond your "free" time is billed to you at a 30 percent discount.





## FREE INSURANCE

As a new NEA member, you are covered with \$15,000 in life insurance at no cost to you for one year! You can keep it, increase it or drop it after this school year—whichever meets your needs.

Plus you will have \$200 in life insurance that accrues each year by \$200 until it reaches \$1,000—again at no cost to you. This is your free life insurance as long as you are an NEA member.

And there is more! You also have \$50,000 in accidental death life insurance the moment you join NEA. It covers any accident that happens while you are performing your education employment or association leadership duties.

## POLITICAL ACTION

MNEA members decide if office holders and candidates measure up on education issues. Trained members meet in local groups to interview candidates and report their findings to the Political Action Committee council, which the MNEA Representative Assembly elects. The PAC council also reviews the voting records of officeholders. Only at the end of this process does MNEA PAC recommend candidates who measure up for children and public education.

## YOUR VOICE AT THE CAPITOL

MNEA membership gives you a voice in policy making and decisions that improve education, fund public schools, reduce class size, ensure safe schools, secure technology resources, protect your retirement and the education profession, and expand community involvement in schools. In addition, MNEA delivers:

- Full-time lobbyists working on your behalf in the Missouri legislature and U.S. Congress
- Online Legislative Action Center that makes communication about education issues with your legislators easy
- Daily and weekly state and federal legislative updates when legislators are in session
- Campaigns to elect pro-education lawmakers and work to defeat dangerous ballot issues like the Amendment 3, which aimed at evaluating teachers primarily on student performance mandating more testing and a one-size-fits-all approach to education

## Free Insurance

Members receive, at no cost to them, insurance coverage of \$50,000 for job-related accidental death and dismemberment; up to \$1,000 in basic life insurance; and up to \$5,000 for accidental death and dismemberment that is not job related. New members also have \$15,000 in life insurance their first year, which may be kept (or increased) and converted to an individual ongoing plan.

## Car Insurance
